GriefShare starting March 2. Have you recently lost a loved one? This group is open to all who have recently lost a loved one but we will be focusing specifically on widows and widowers at this time for this group.

We will be meeting at Old Zionsville UCC, 5981 Fountain Road, Old Zionsville, PA (at the bottom of the hill at Kings Highway and Fountain Road - big stone building)

on **Tuesdays starting March 2 and running through the end of May at 1:00 p.m. in the afternoon.** Each session lasts about 1.5 hours. Enter the church by the office door on the Fountain Road side of the building. Members and non-members of the church are welcome and encouraged to attend so we can support one another. We will meet in the Upper Social Room. **All Welcome**. The group is free to participate but we ask a donation of \$15 or whatever you can share for the workbook.

Please sign up with Pastor Lori if you are planning to attend. Attending the first session does not lock you into the whole series, but we do hope to have a great group gathered to learn and support each other. Please invite your friends or others who may benefit from this group. Another group will run in the fall to cover all kinds of deaths in the families of our community. You can participate in the program more than once. People who have done so say they have learned more going through it the second time as they continue to heal.


Here are the basics of what GriefShare is about:

News from our Food Pantry...

Zionsville Area Food Pantry is located at Zion's Lutheran Church; their mailing address is P.O. Box 56, Old Zionsville, PA 18068. Their phone number is 610-554-8340, you may text. The distribution for the food pantry is always the second Monday and following Wednesday and Saturday of each month. Monday and Wednesday distribution is 4-6 pm. Saturday distribution is 10 a.m. to 12 noon. You are always welcome to help and/or to visit/observe. It is a great operation. Clients are encouraged to have appointments but we do accept walk-ins too. During the Pandemic, distribution is drive-up in the parking lot. Parking attendants will help you park and wait for distribution. As church leaders, feel free to suggest to folks in need that this is available to them. They should call the phone number for a recorded message that explains the process to them.

For those who would like to help in other ways – Food can be dropped off at the church on Wednesday, Thursday and Friday from 8:00am–1:00pm. If you choose to do this, please check the expiration date and the quality of the item. No dented cans, opened

containers can be accepted. They need future dated or items which are no more than 6 months past the expiration date.

- Send a financial gift made payable to: Zionsville Area Food Pantry, P.O. Box 56, Old Zionsville, PA 18068. The Pantry is a 501c3 corporation, so your donations are tax deductible.
- Host a Food Drive. Contact the food pantry about what is most needed, and have a food drive with your organization or friends.


