We will be worshipping in February, studying the Gospel of Luke, as we look ahead to Lent which begins on March 2, with Ash Wednesday. Prepare your hearts!


News from the Windows Committee...

While in the process of removing the Good **Sindows** Shepherd window last December, the to the **Future** Cumberland crew was excited to uncover some historical information carved into the decorative molding. Although not contributing to the stained glass installation itself, it appears that Alvin M. Handwerk produced the woodwork encasing the glass. His name, date of June 27, 1910 and Slatington, Pa can clearly be seen etched in the molding. Alvin was born October 15, 1880 in Slatington and lived there most of his life. His father was in the building business and he and his brother Amandus were both carpenters. Alvin was a member of St. John's Lutheran Church in Slatington. He died April 9, 1967 and is buried in the Union Cemetery in Slatington. We are grateful to Robin Yoder who grew up in Slatington and to her cousin's son




Michael Hofmann, who is a "known historian of all things Slatington", for sharing this information.
