## News from the Windows Committee...

Windows to the Future - "Looking Back"



The Property Committee had been discussing the restoration of the sanctuary windows for some time, but it wasn't until March 27, 2019 that a subcommittee of Pastor Lori, Beth Massa and Ruth Stansfield met to determine the feasibility and scope of the project. Over the next year, the committee learned a great deal about the restoration of stained glass and the terminology of the industry from representatives of five stained glass studios who made on-site inspections. Fund raising activities began and thanks to Jane Bedell and Beth Massa a "Windows to the Future" logo was created. The fifth studio to visit was Cumberland Stained Glass, Mechanicsburg on March 6, 2020, one year from the committee's formation and just prior to Covid. Cumberland was selected to oversee the project and a contract was signed May 12 for Phase 1, restoration of the twin windows flanking the organ. The windows were removed in October and returned by Christmas. During the spring of 2021 the protective coverings were installed and the trim was painted, completing this phase at a cost of \$25,000. With Phase 1 fully funded, contracts were signed for Phase 2, the complete restoration of the Good

Shepherd windows. The twin windows were restored and returned just before Thanksgiving and the Good Shepherd window was removed in early December. We are pleased to report that the restored window has been returned and the results are exceptional. The protective covering and exterior molding repair and painting will take place soon. The cost of this phase is \$86,000 and is 100% funded thanks to the generosity of the congregation, memorial donations, the Village School, and fund raising activities. It is hard to believe that the "official" journey has been underway for three successful years. Congratulations to all! Stay tuned for "Looking Ahead" to Phase 3 in the April newsletter.

Collection will continue **until April 1**. Bring items to the pew outside of my office OR I will be happy to come to your place (within the Emmaus/Zionsville area) to pick up items you want to share. These items will be taken for **recycling/shredding**. This is **NOT** the same as donating to the **ATF (All Things Free - for our food pantry clients to have)** room. Please continue to share items with ATF that are usable.

Grab a box or a bag and fill it with the things you want to recycle/share. All items need to be clean (but can be stained/torn/holey/etc).

Items to consider include:

- bedding, including pillows, linens, curtains, potholders, dish towels, etc. (stained, torn, etc.)
- shoes (all sizes and kinds) Please place all shoes together in a white trash bag.
- clothing including bras, socks, hats, scarves, gloves, underwear, etc.
- slippers, belts, costumes
- video tapes, cassette tapes, cds, vinyl records - including cases
- computers and components
- small appliances that don't work

- video players, cd players, etc.
- batteries - all kinds
- light bulbs
- phone books, instructional books, educational cds/computer cds/text books
- cell phones, cables, electrical cords, floppy disks, telephones
- cameras and accessories
- GPS systems
- ink cartridges/toner cartridges
- pagers, office machines, printers
- game systems and cartridges/cassettes
- thermostats
- items containing mercury - thermometers

Dear Old Zionsville UCC congregation and groups,

The Zionsville Area Food Pantry wishes to thank you and acknowledge your gifts throughout 2021. The thoughtful support of people like you allows us to continue our mission. Thank you for your donation of \$ 325.

As the pandemic continues, we made some changes throughout 2021. June brought the opportunity to finally move our distribution indoors after 15 months of operations as a drive thru in the parking lot. We continue to have clients wait in queue in their cars and limit the number in the building at any one time. This slows down distributions but allows them to again make selections to their liking. Masks are required for unvaccinated clients and volunteers and strongly suggested for everyone.

We wanted share news that we benefitted from the Care Act funds allocated to Upper Milford Township. These funds allowed us to purchase additional racks which make setup and cleanup much faster on distribution days. We also were able to replace our old commercial refrigerator with 2 new ones, increasing out capacity to store and distribute produce, eggs, butter, and other perishable items.



Unfortunately, the disease progressed rather rapidly, and she is now facing end-stage renal failure, which will require a life-saving kidney transplant. Audrey is only 35 years old and deserves to have many more happy and healthy years ahead of her.

Audrey has been working harder than ever these past few years, working overtime as a paramedic, through the pandemic, to make sure she can save enough money to cover the costs of her illness and complications, as well as sustain a period of disability, while waiting for and recovering from a transplant.

Unfortunately, many unexpected costs are associated with transplant surgeries, including transportation, lodging, and lost wages for a potential living donor. The recovery period could be weeks, or months, long. The money we are trying to raise will go toward paying these costs for a donor, to make sure their expenses are covered.

This is a very stressful time for Audrey. She is attempting to continue to live her normal life; working as long as she can, and taking care of her fur babies. She is also an animal rescuer/foster and still constantly takes in animals in need until they can find good homes. All while balancing continuous medical procedures and declining health. Knowing that a potential donor and other expenses would be taken care of financially, will be a huge relief to her.

Any additional funds will be donated to charities that assist others with transplant needs, or will go toward assisting diabetics in receiving their life-sustaining medication.
