**At 12:30 p.m., there will be a fun presentation by Mr. Donald Heminitz, portraying an early 1770s schoolmaster traveling the King's Highway who stops to visit the Upper Milford schoolhouse. Several resources have been used in developing a character, including the 1955 book *THE SCHOOLHOUSE Near the Old Spring*, written by Andrew S. Berky, then Director of the Schwenkfelder Library. With a walking stick in hand and a tricorn hat, Mr. Heminitz will include a colonial-themed spelling bee, so be sure to practice thine olde timey words! Additionally, he will provide some musical entertainment on fife and Baroque flute to enrich his performance.**

**For several years, Mr. Heminitz, formerly a resident of Old Zionsville, was a living history interpreter portraying the Pilgrims through first-person interaction at Plimoth Patuxet Museums in Plymouth, Massachusetts, and currently serves as Bosun and Marine Repair Supervisor aboard *Mayflower II*.**
