Join us every third Sunday after Sunday School and before Worship for "**Third Sunday Treats**". Everyone is invited to share in this time of fellowship! If you


would like to bake or make special treats please speak to Pastor Lori. There is also a signup sheet in the rear of the Sanctuary.



During worship on September 11th, the committee reported on the financial status of the final phase of the project. The first part, restoration of the nativity window, will cost

\$44,975. The account balance is currently \$34,978. With a successful challenge of \$6,000, we will be just \$4,000 shy of our goal to sign a contract to restore the nativity window. Quite amazing!

Not only do your dollars count, but so do your pennies! The change jar was emptied for the third time this year and we are happy to report that you have donated \$499 in loose change during 2022. NATIONAL FIRE PREVENTION MONTH

October is National Fire Prevention Month and that means it's time for us all to take the precautionary steps to prevent dangerous and life-threatening fires. Smoke Alarms are a key part of a home fire escape plan. When there is a fire, smoke spreads fast. Working smoke alarms give you early warning so you can get outside quickly.

Facts:

- A closed door may slow the spread of smoke, heat and fire.
- Smoke alarms should be installed on every level.
- Roughly 3 out of 5 fire deaths happen in homes with no smoke alarms.

NATIONAL FIRE PREVENTION WEEK HISTORY

The National Fire Protection Association founded National Fire Prevention Week in 1922. The observance takes place the week of October 9th, commemorating the date of the Great Chicago Fire in 1871. In later years, the organization expanded its efforts to include the entire month of October.
