2023 BUDGET

Enclosed is the draft of the 2023 budget which will be discussed and voted on at the congregational meeting on Dec 4 .

Background:

- As you will see, we budgeted to be at a deficit and have exceeded it for 2022.
- (not included on the spreadsheet) The 2021 budget was for a ~\$12,000 deficit which was covered by the PPP payroll programs during the pandemic.
- A similar shortfall was planned for 2022 with hopes that income would improve. Income
 declined while we continued to be frugal with our spending.

2023

- The budget looks even worse.
- We have removed any equipment purchases in the capital budget and asked that property only
 use the \$5000 line item for things that cannot be deferred.
- Increases of 2% or less have been included for staff. This is below conference guidance.
- Utilities have been increased in anticipation of further rate hikes.
- We need to look at sources of income. Please come prepared to discuss
