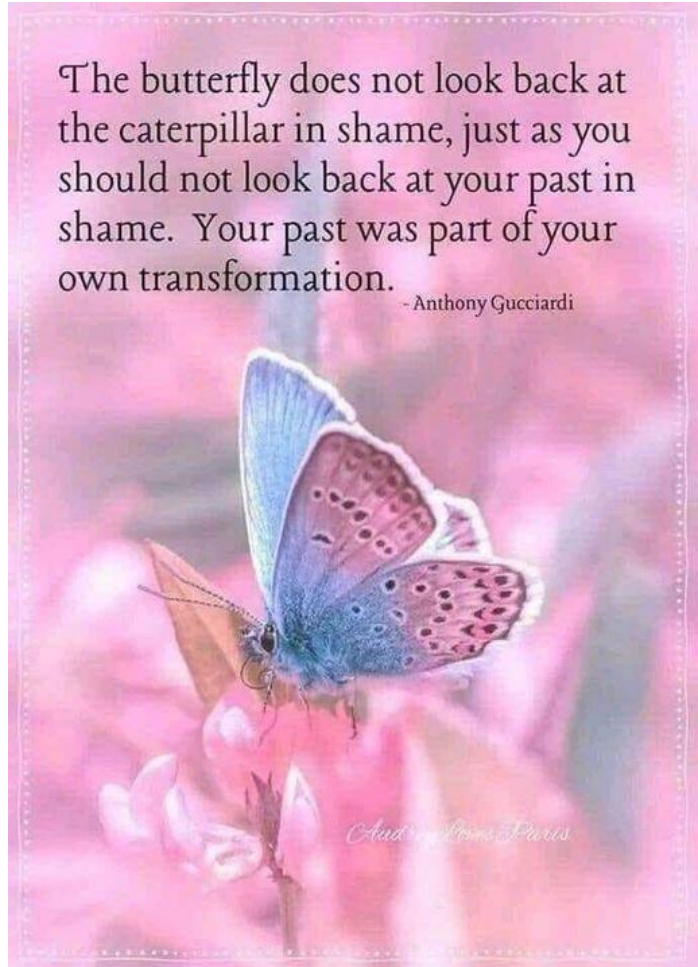

Sunday School is open to all children who would like to participate. Children can start at the age of two or when they are potty trained. Classes are held in the lower level of the church. If you have other questions about Sunday School, please speak with Pastor Lori, Susan Jacobs or Deb Schoenberger.

Would you like to purchase a new **Bible** that has an interactive feature that can work with your cell phone, iPad or other electronic device? We presented our confirmands with these Bibles and purchased extras in case YOU or a person you know may like one too. The holidays are coming and this could make a lovely, affordable gift. The cost is **\$16 each**. By setting it up with your device, the program can actually "read scripture to you." So for someone who drives lots or prefers to listen to the Holy Word, this could be very appealing. The Filament app is very simple to use. You simply scan a page number in the Bible to instantly access study notes, devotionals from famous authors, interactive maps, teaching videos and worship music. If you have a loved one who likes to hear scripture before they go to sleep, this would be perfect for them too.

Please **let Pastor Lori know** if you would like to purchase any number of these Bibles. There are two cover styles: black and floral, they are zipper case protected, and are very small - about the size of your hand. Print is small, but these other features bring the Bible to life in a whole new way. See Pastor Lori for more information.

It has been interesting to share thoughts and ideas together as we grow our faith and perspective on the elusive young adult population and how we might listen to ways to engage them in growing their faith too. The book, "Hear Us Out" is available at the Library or on free download to your digital device. Written by local pastors led by Sue Pizor Yoder, they interviewed over 200 individuals between the ages of 18 - 40 to discover information about inspiration, belonging, values, adversity, legacy, and faith experiences. The book is divided into 6 sections, perfect for each week of Lent, that will open our eyes to the thoughts of folks in this age group and how we might perceive differently how to reach out and support them as we assess how our churches can make this leap to serving all ages. Our last session will be on March 24, and for that specific day, we are fortunate to welcome The Rev. Dr. Bonnie Bates to our class to speak with us about her experience in participating in the writers group of this book!
