

The cost is **\$16 each**. By setting it up with your device, the program can actually "read scripture to you." The Filament app is very simple to use. You simply scan a page number in the Bible to instantly access study notes, devotionals from famous authors, interactive maps, teaching videos and worship music. If you have a loved one who likes to hear scripture before they go to sleep, this would be perfect for them too.

There are two cover styles: black and floral, they are zipper case protected, and are very small - about the size of your hand. News About Our Parsonage...

Parsonage Revitalization Project Planning

Some of you may have already heard my update at church, but sharing here for a wider audience. On the approval of property, finance, and consistory, I have been authorized to form a planning committee to address future maintenance / improvements / renovations at the parsonage. The property has been rented for over 10 years with no work other than necessary maintenance and repairs of mechanical systems like heat, and plumbing, as well as some appliance replacement. In order to maintain the property value and ensure higher future rental income, we need to start evaluating and planning.

I am looking for individuals who have interest or skills, as well as those to support the collective memory of past activities and reasons for those choices. Looking for men and women who can assist with research, forming a project plan and create a proposal for church approval, as well as actually doing the work. The more labor we can manage within the congregation, the less we will need to spend, and the greater our return on investment.

Some interesting facts have found are: the kitchen cabinets are 60 years old and the exterior paint was last applied 50 years ago. We have much to address.

News from the Property Committee....

There have been recent questions from members of the congregation regarding fundraising for the gas line project. In an effort to be transparent with all members, the following is what has transpired. In November, 2023, there was a concern from church members regarding the smell of gas in the downstairs area. Members of the church investigated and adjusted the pilot lights on the stove. In the meantime, UGI was in for an inspection and pressure tested the gas line. Although no leaks were present, UGI deemed the underground gas line as unsafe and placed a yellow tag on the system for repair. If a leak were to happen, it would go unnoticed until it was too late. The old line is to be capped off and placed above ground in line with the rest of the system and per UGI, must be done by a qualified HVAC Contractor. The contractor who regularly assists the Church with HVAC issues was contacted and, since he is familiar with the Church HVAC system, he will make the repair once the heating system is not needed. The cost will depend on how long it takes to cut through the stone wall to make the proper connection. If anyone would like to assist with this portion of the property, please contact the Church office.

THE "ALL THINGS FREE" ROOM FIVE YEAR CELEBRATION

Clients include individuals and families who participate in the Zionsville Area Food Pantry, the Macungie Food Cupboard, the Emmaus Groceries Plus Program, and others brought to our attention in their time of need. The Committee relies totally on donations from our congregation and other generous sources from the community.

The ATF is a sub-committee of the FUN Group. We are grateful for the support of Pastor Lori, our church staff, members of Zions Lutheran Church and Pastor Tom, the Zionsville Area Food Pantry Board and, of course the members and friends of our congregation.
