# From Pastor's Desk...

#### Dear Friends,

Dr. Lauren Mosbeck, a Philadelphia-based licensed professional counselor who specializes in child and teen mental health writes that "Goal setting gives children and teens a sense of responsibility and purpose." She adds, "As children and teens begin to form their identities, it is important for them to feel positive about themselves, their interests, and their achievements."

Resolutions can be simple goals that allow for comfortable and satisfying successes.

Here are few suggestions I found and share with you.

First, for the little ones:

- I will share my toys with my siblings and friends.
- I will put my toys away after playing.
- I will try a bite of new food.
- I will always say thank you when someone helps me or gives me something.
- I will use my words to share my feelings.
- I will learn a new way to help Mommy and Daddy.

The 6-12 year old young ones:

- I will eat more vegetables with my meals.
- I will set a savings goal for my allowance or money gifts.
- I will read thirty minutes each day.
- I will limit video games to 1 or 2 hours a day.
- I will keep my room neat and organized.
- I will learn a new skill for my favorite sport.

Staples will accept the following kinds of batteries for recycling and our church will get credit for taking them in. I have small boxes **at the front and ramp doors for your "contributions." Or you can put bags of batteries outside of my office. Thanks!**

Lithium ion (Li-Ion) Nickel metal hydride (Ni-MH) Nickel zinc (Ni-ZN) Non-rechargeable lithium Rechargeable nickel cadmium (Ni-Cd) Single-use alkaline Small sealed lead acid (SSLA/Pb)

**Offering Box** - A secure box is located in the rear of the sanctuary for you to deposit your offering **or** other important papers if you happen to be in the church when the office isn't open. It has been secured to the floor and is locked. It will be opened on a Sunday morning so the offerings in there can be combined with those in worship that day. Thanks for your continued support of our church.



Our Church is now equipped with an **Assistive Listening System**. You provide your own headphones which can be connected to the transmitter which will allow you to more clearly hear the Worship Service or any program being offered in the Sanctuary. See anyone at the sound booth to inquire.

There are two **Bulletin Magnifier Sheets** available for you to use in worship. They are the size of a full sheet of paper and can be found in the side pocket on the sound system. Pick one up and try it out, then return it to the sound system after worship.
