In case you don't know...

A penny party is an event where guests purchase tickets to bid on items and prizes. Penny parties are also known as penny socials, tricky trays, lucky number dinners, and chance auctions. It combines elements of raffles and silent auctions.

How it works

- Guests buy tickets, which are worth one bid each
- Guests drop their tickets into buckets for items they want to win
- The more tickets a guest buys, the higher their chances of winning
- A winning ticket is drawn at random, and the guest who placed that ticket wins the item

Into the Dreamtime Healing Sound Bath

FUN Group is considering sponsoring a Dreamtime Sound Healing program in the near future. Maureen (Moe) of Lehigh Valley Drum Circle and the Large Flowerheads offers an onsite sound meditation program.

Sound meditation is the next generation of relaxation. She offers sound meditation with crystal singing bowls and gongs. A gong bath is a deep listening experience that will allow you to journey or take you to a meditative state. The result will leave you feeling rejuvenated and revitalized.

The program lasts 90 minutes, which includes relaxation exercise to begin and time for grounding when the meditation is over. She performs in the sanctuary and people can lay on the floor or sit/lay in the pews. You are welcome to bring pillows and/or blankets for your comfort.

Single-use alkaline
Small sealed lead acid (SSLA/Pb)
