It has been secured to the floor and is locked. It will be opened on a Sunday morning so the offerings in there can be combined with those in worship that day. Our Church is now equipped with an **Assistive Listening System**. You provide your own headphones which can be connected to the transmitter which will allow you to more clearly hear the Worship Service or any program being offered in the Sanctuary. See anyone at the sound booth to inquire.

There are two **Bulletin Magnifier Sheets** available for you to use in worship. They are the size of a full sheet of paper and can be found in the side pocket on the sound system. Pick one up and try it out, then return it to the sound system after worship.

35th General Synod Keystone Conference Resolution

DATES for this General Synod – July 11-15, 2025 in Kansas City, MO.

WHEREAS the four UCC Conferences in Pennsylvania affirm:

Devotion to our Creator God, to Jesus Christ and the Holy Spirit;

Recognize that division and change will create new communities;

Believe a Conference must model unity and healing in response;

Serve, Nurture, and Empower authorized ministers/leaders within it;

Desire to live into Jesus' hope that followers reflect unity... AND

WHEREAS the four Conferences have collectively discerned that their ministry and mission will be stronger together:

Keystone Conference - previously the four PA conferences - GRANT standing as a Conference in the UCC as of January 1, 2026 and APPROVE termination of the previous four PA conferences.

STAR Resolution Summaries: (call PNEC for full resolution language)

WHEREAS, 80% of the Churches in the United Church of Christ are located in rural areas and small towns and (to summarize) they do a whole lot of really great and often unique things for the church, their communities and the UCC.... Be it resolved that:

- ...The UCC recognizes the STAR Coalition (Small Towns And Rural churches) as a representative group and has representation during all the meetings, worship, and resolution planning.
- ...The UCC find ways to encourage leadership to celebrate and empower STAR congregations as they find their own way...
- ...that the Collegium of Officers will organize a task force to ensure that STAR congregations and communities continue to have their voice heard and their presence celebrated.
- ...that the STAR Coalition will be empowered to share information with United Church of Christ seminaries, seminarians, and those seeking a Call and role of leadership...
- ...STAR Coalition reports to the Executive Council at the Thirty-sixth General Synod on how the Collegium is responding to the voices...
- ...they become a center for celebration, sharing, support, and guidance for any STAR congregations, communities and the people who serve them....

TRANSITIONAL STAFFING - BEGINNING IN JANUARY 2026

After determining interest among current ministerial staff, D. Ackerman, C. Call, N. Foust, and K. McLemore expressed interest in the *transitional* full-time ministerial positions and due to their experience working with local churches, will be considered by the new Keystone Board for transitional positions.

The **transitional staff** will be contracted by the Keystone Board **in the fall of 2025** beginning with the Transitional Executive Conference Minister.

That *Transitional Executive Conference Minister*, with the *Personnel Committee* and the *Transitional Board* will complete interviews with the transitional ordained and administrative staff so that the individuals can **begin in January 2026.**

We anticipate 12-18 months of transition so that work can continue. After that point searches for settled staff will begin.

The administrative positions may be hired for "settled" administrative staff during the first months or year of the transition.

SETTLED STAFFING TO BEGIN SOMETIME IN 2027

There will be search committees formed for all the called positions in the Keystone Conference which include:

- 1. Executive Conference Minister
- 2. Three Regional Ministers
- 3. Leadership and Faith Formation position part-time

These will be open searches which may include those who have served as transitional staff, but their continued employment/call is not quaranteed.
