## From Pastor's Desk...

### The Goose Story

by Dr. Harry Clarke Noyes

ARCS NEWS, Vol. 7, No. 1, January 1992

Next  
fall, when  
you see Geese  
heading South for  
the Winter, flying along  
in V formation, you might  
consider what science has dis-  
covered as to why they fly that way:  
as each bird flaps its wings, it creates an  
uplift for the bird immediately following. By  
flying in V formation the whole flock adds at least  
71% greater flying range than if each bird flew on its own.

***People who share a common direction and sense of community  
can get where they are going more quickly and easily  
because they are traveling on the thrust of one another.***

When  
a goose falls  
out of formation,  
it suddenly feels the drag  
and resistance of trying to go it alone  
and quickly gets back into formation to take  
advantage of the lifting power of the bird in front.

***If we have as much sense as a goose,  
we will stay in formation  
with those who are headed the same way we are.***

When  
the Head Goose  
gets tired, it rotates back  
in the wing and another goose flies point.

***It is sensible to take turns doing demanding jobs  
with people or with geese flying South.***



Join the Lehigh Valley Chorale on Saturday, May 9, for our spring concert series, The Road Home, celebrating 10 years of our group. These concerts are a celebration of where we came from, where we are, and where our incredible ensemble is going. Concerts will be held at Miller Symphony Hall in Allentown at 2:00 and 7:00 PM.

Do you have **batteries** ready to throw away? Don't throw them away! **Bring them to the church to recycle!!** We are still collecting **all kinds of batteries to recycle** at Staples. To date we have raised over \$200 toward Staples purchases. There are small boxes at the front and ramp doors for your "contributions." Or you can put bags of batteries outside of Pastor Lori's office. Thanks! Keep them coming. You are an awesome support of this interesting way to recycle and get credit at Staples for future purchases.



Staples will accept the following kinds of batteries for recycling:

Batteries to recycle by bringing them to the boxes at church:

- Lithium ion (Li-Ion)
- Nickel metal hydride (Ni-MH)
- Nickel zinc (Ni-ZN)
- Non-rechargeable lithium
- Rechargeable nickel cadmium (Ni-Cd)
- Single-use alkaline
- Small sealed lead acid (SSLA/Pb)

They accept ink cartridges too!

**Offering Box** - A secure box is located in the rear of the sanctuary for you to deposit your offering **or** other important papers if you happen to be in the church when the office isn't open. It has been secured to the wall and is locked. It will be opened on a Sunday morning so the offerings in there can be combined with those in worship that day.
